Welcome to the All New ACU British Vet Motocross Championships 2023

Firstly we would like to thank you for entering the all new ACU British Vet Championships. We really hope you have an enjoyable and fun weekend of racing.

The idea for this event started back in 2018 when Luton and District Club committee member Laurence Wiltshire attended the World Vets Championships at Glen Helen in California. The relaxed vibe one weekend event where older riders of varying ages and skills raced against each other in their own classes really seemed to work for VET riders who typically do not have the time to dedicate to a multi round championship.

Experiencing this event and realising that around half of all MX riders in the UK are "VET" riders it seemed a shame that there wasn't something similair in the UK. And so the idea was born, and 4 and half years later we have the first of what will hopefully be many years of the ACU British Vet Championships.

This is the first year of the event so no doubt there will be some learnings along the way but please be assured we are all working really hard to make the event as good as possible you the riders.

WHAT IS IT?

A 2 day festival of racing dedicated to veteran (vet) riders of all ages and skill levels. There is a range of age based and skill based race classes to choose from with the bragging rights of being an ACU British Champion up for grabs for the best of the best in each age group.

All elements of the event have been designed to suit vet racers, from the track choice and preparation to the off track entertainment. Our focus is on making the most enjoyable and memorable event possible for the vet racers and the spectators that attend.

WHO IS IT FOR?

This race meeting is for anyone over the age of 30 who can race a motocross bike. We have race classes based on age and skill level. Each race class will get its own race and classification. This ensures you are racing against people of a similar age and skill level to yourself, which makes the racing more enjoyable for everyone.

We want to encourage all vet dirtbike riders to come have a go so whether you are an expert level racer at the top of your game or someone that hasn't raced for 20 years then we have a race for you. (just not the same race..)

HOW DOES IT WORK

There are 4 ACU British Championship classes

- +30 (for riders between the ages of 30 and 39) (Yellow rider bibs)
- +40 (for riders between the ages of 40 and 49) (Black rider bibs)
- +50 (for riders between the ages of 50 and 59) (Dark Blue rider bibs)
- +60 (for riders over the age of 60) (Red rider bibs)

And there will be the following support classes

- +30 Novice (for riders between the ages of 30 and 39) (Grey rider bibs)
- +30 Inter (for riders between the ages of 30 and 39) (Orange rider bibs)
- +40 Novice (for riders between the ages of 40 and 49) (Light Blue rider bibs)
- +40 Inter (for riders between the ages of 40 and 49) (White rider bibs)
- +50 Novice (for riders between the ages of 50 and 59) (Maroon rider bibs)
- +50 Inter (for riders between the ages of 50 and 59) (Green rider bibs)

Each class will get 1 timed qualifying practice and 6 races across the 2 days

Some classes are combined but each class gets its own dedicated gate drop and race its own race. You can tell which class a rider is in by the colour of the bib they are wearing.

The top 6 competitors in all classes will be awarded a Vet Motocross Championships trophy and will have a top 6 riding number reserved for them in that class for the following year. (other than the top 3 in the novice and inter classes who will have to move up a class the following year.)

Useful Info

Parking

We have nearly 300 riders attending the event so please park as close together as you can. Please do not create any social square camps. Some of our team will be on hand to "help" with parking so please follow their instructions as best you can. A lot of the venue is on a slope so you might want to bring your levelling blocks if camping.

Signing on

Signing on and collection of transponders will be open from Friday at 3.00pm and Saturday from 08.00am in the big marquee tent located near the finish line

You will need to show your ACU licence, as the licences are now only electronic (2) we suggest you download your competitor Licence to your phone and save it to your wallet. Your licence should look like this:



If you don't have a licence or are unable to show your QR Code, you will require a one event/ day licence.

If you have purchased a 12 month ACU licence and do not have your QR Code, please follow these steps:

- Log on to your ACU profile.
- Click on "ACU_competitor_licences"
- Click on: Your current status which is highlighted in green.
- Click on: "Resend ACU Competitors License email"

An email will be then sent out so you can then download your QR code, don't forget to save it in your e wallet or screenshot it so it can be scanned when signing in.

If you need a one event day licence then you will need to fill in the one event licence from when signing on. Most of you will have pre-paid for this option in advance but if you haven't then our team will ask you to pay £15 on the day for this licence.

Transponders

If you are using your own transponder, please ensure you have entered the correct transponder number on your entry.

If you are hiring a transponder you will collect this from the big marquee located near the finish line, you will need to take a refundable deposit of £20, if you do not have a bracket for your bike to hold the transponder these can be purchased for an additional £10.

Once your weekends racing is over, please return your hired transponder to the <u>marquee</u>, where your £20 deposit will be refunded. ID maybe required when receiving your cash/other ID.

If you do not return your transponder or you lose it then the cost to replace it is £450. Part of the hire agreement you will sign is accepting this cost.

Scrutineering

Scrutineering will be open from in the big marquee tent located near the finish line. Opening times in schedule. All Bikes and Helmets must be scrutineered prior to signing on, please ensure all old zip ties and ACU stickers from previous races are removed.

Please ensure your bike is in good working order and you are displaying the correct number that you have used to enter the race. Race numbers should be on ALL 3 number boards and be in plain black or white graphics.

Other checks on the day include:

- Lever ends are in place and there are no sharp ends.
- Bar Grips are in good condition and not worn through on the ends.
- Wheel bearings have no movement.
- Your throttle tube twists freely.
- Front sprocket guards are in place.

Helmets must be displaying a gold ACU sticker similar to that shown below, Straps should be in good condition.



Wristbands for riders and public

We have 3 coloured wristbands that will be used through out the event

Pink bands – Show riders have signed on and must be worn by all riders on Saturday and Sunday

Yellow bands - Gain access for the whole weekend - £10 each (each riders gets given 2 at signing on for free)

Green bands - Saturday only access - £6 each

Rider Bibs

Each rider gets a commemorative rider bib which shows which is colour coded to show which group the rider is in. If they entered by May 15th then the bib will also have their rider number on.

All riders MUST wear their bib or they will not be allowed on to the track

As 2 groups will be on the track at the same time then this helps the riders and spectators to know who is in which group

2 Gate drops

Each race will have 2 gate drops. This is a fairly new way of doing things in the UK but this method has been used for years in the USA. In particular at the World Vets that is held at Glen Helen.

In the holding pen will be 2 areas. 1 for the riders in the class that is "Gate drop 1" and the other for the "Gate Drop 2" riders.

When the start team are ready gate drop 1 riders will be asked to take the place on the gate. Gate drop 2 riders will then be asked to line up behind the gate.

Once the COC is ready the Gate drop 1 riders will be put under starters orders – 15 second board, 5 second board then gate drops.

The start team will immediately reset the gate while the gate 2 riders take their position behind the gate.

They are then under starters orders and take the 15 second board, 5 second board and gate drop.

The second gate should drop about 45 seconds after the first. Or sooner if possible.

This is a relatively new way of doing things so bear with us..

Gate Pick

Riders lap times will be recorded in their 5 lap practice session with their fastest time dictating which gate pick position they get. With the fastest time getting first pick and the slowest getting last pick. This gate pick position will be your gate pick for the whole weekend so do your best! The good news is that you can get a hole shot from almost anywhere on the Toddington start gate so if you don't quite nail it in qualifying then don't worry too much.

Points System and Trophies

Riders will be scored as per their finishing position in each race. Their total points across the 2 days will dictate their overall position. They will score 1 point for 1^{st} place 2 for 2^{nd} and so on down to 40 for 40^{th} . The rider with the lowest points across the 2 days wins. Eg 6 x 1^{st} place = 6 points beats 6 x2 place = 12 points.

In the event of a tie break the rider with the best finishing position wins eg if one has a best finishing of 3rd and the other has best finishing position of 2rd then the one with the 2rd position wins. If there is a still a tie then the rider who does the best in the last race wins.

Trophies will be awarded to the top 6 riders in each group (excluding the Luton support race)

The winner of each of the Championship classes will be invited to the ACU prize ceremony at the end of the year to receive their official championship medal.

DRUG & ALCOHOL ABUSE

Any Rider or their associate caught abusing drugs or alcohol will be disqualified, asked to leave, and reported to the ACU Head Office in accordance with Chapter 9 of the National Sporting Code.

Flags Signals

Please take note of the following rule change regarding flag signals:

 Yellow Waved: Great danger, prepare to stop, no overtaking. A significant reduction in speed must be seen; therefore, jumps should not be attempted.

Camping

Competitors can camp from Friday afternoon and must vacate the venue on Sunday by 7:30pm. We do not have fresh water on site so if camping please bring enough of your own drinking water with you. We will have security roaming the site each but please remember to keep your valuables locked up. Generators and anything else noisy to be off by 10:30pm.

Beer Tent / Marquee

We have a 24m x 9m Marquee with bar open in the afternoon/ evening of both event days. Background music will play via DJ system but no live band or DJ as we need to be careful on noise in the evening.

Commentator + Commentary form

We will have experience commentator and rider Phil Gee commentating (and also riding) at the event. Laurence Wiltshire will support Phil in commentating when Phil is riding / not available.
